## CONDITIONS

### Competition Guidelines

- 1 NRHA approved (except Green Horse/Rider, Ladies & Mens, Freestyle) and NRHA rules apply where applicable.
- 2 Green Horse/Green Rider Rule: Eligible Rider or Horse cannot have accumulated more than \$100 in NRHA earnings as of Jan 1, 2023.
- 3 Club Green classes may show one- or two-handed in any legal bridle but must do flying lead change, simple lead change will incur penalty.
- 4 Entries for the first class each day will close at the conclusion of the last class the preceding day. All other classes will close **two classes prior**.
- 5 Show committee to retain 50% of entry fees (exception Green Reiner, TRFAM qualifiers 100%)
- 6 KRHA will mail payback checks to person on file after final verification by NRHA
- 7 Horses entered in concurrent classes will only pay highest judges fee
- 8 **The Run For A Million (TRFAM) qualifier classes:** The qualifying classes will run concurrent with Rookie 2 and Ancillary Non Pro divisions. Entry fee is \$200/division/slate. Exhibitors are required to enter into the corresponding NRHA event divisions to be eligible for (TRFAM) Qualifier. The top 5 placings plus ties/slate qualify to compete at The Run For A Million 2024! Zero and No Scores do not qualify.

### Fees and Payment

- \$30 per horse Office Fee will be assessed
  - \$10 per horse NRHA drug fee will be assessed
  - \$20 per run video fee will be assessed-you *will* get a copy of your run
- Checks payable to KRHA**
- \*Exhibitors that have previously written insufficient funds checks at any past KRHA show must pay for stalls, paid warm ups and entries with cash or a cashier's check.

**RV/Camper Hookups** are available on the show grounds.

### Stalls - Shavings - Paid Warm Ups

Stalls for entire circuit **\$165** - No outside shavings  
Single night stall fee: **\$100**  
Jump out fee **\$50** per horse  
*Tack splits-show office will no longer split stalls*  
Shavings can be ordered for pre-bed (\$10/bag)  
by Sept 11 (Monday) on our website or by calling Art.
